We at BTMA, and our member clubs, take very seriously our responsibilities towards the welfare and safety of children or young persons under the age of 18. The activities of BTMA and our member clubs, and in accordance with our Child Protection Policy, can involve the photography of children and young persons in relation to :

- Administration (ID badges etc)
- Coaching and training aid
- Advertising, Publicity and Promotional works.

Parental photography forms an enduring part of each family's record of their child's progress, celebration of success and achievement, as well as being an established social practice.

We require parental permission for any photography to be taken, within the normal class or at events.

'Photography' includes photographic prints and transparencies, video, film and digital imaging.

'Events' means any function, meeting, training session or competition of any nature, whether organised or supported or sponsored by BTMA, and/or its member clubs by any means whatsoever, wherever children or young people are the responsibility of BTMA and/or its member clubs, their instructors or members or their Associations staff or members.

- NO video filming, photography or mobile phones are to be used in any changing rooms AT ANY TIME.
- If any student/parent/adult complains or expresses concern their rights will be respected and the photography particular to the concerns, ceased.
